14th March 2022 Parish Meeting Draft Minutes

- 1) Minutes of the Previous Meeting 14th February 2022 agreed and to be signed.
- 2) Matters Arising
 - i) New veranda for the Hut in progress, awaiting planning permission.
 - ii) Static property in Dilkes Lane, enquiry currently with South Somerset Enforcement Officer for further information, Henry Hobhouse to follow up on behalf of parish council.
