i) Press Release - Support for Somerset households with food and energy bills Somerset residents who are struggling to pay the bills could be eligible for support with the cost of food, energy, water, and other essentials over the coming months. Somerset County Council has been allocated £3.8m to distribute before September 30th as part of the second round of funding provided through the Government's Household Support Fund. Just over £1.2m will be used during the school holidays to provide food vouchers worth £10 a week to children

eligible for Free School Meals and a further £1.3m will be used for one-off payments of £100 to residents on Pension Credit.
